

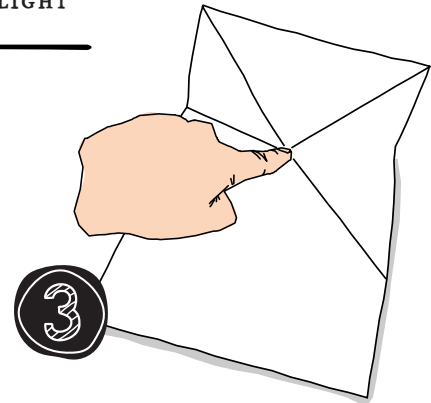
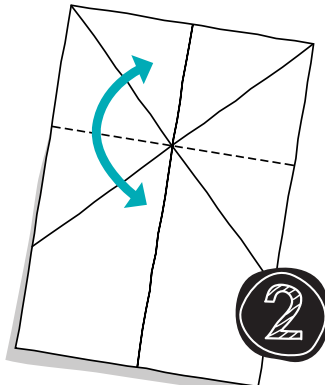
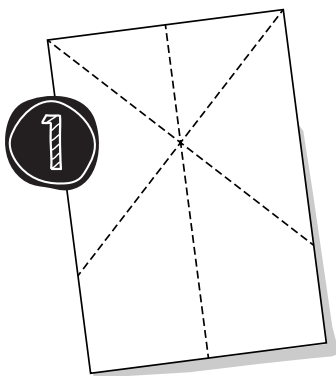
# PAPER PLANES

INSPIRED BY THE 'MECHANICAL FLIGHT'

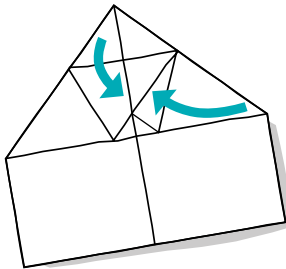


Pop the paper by touching the middle of the intersecting creases

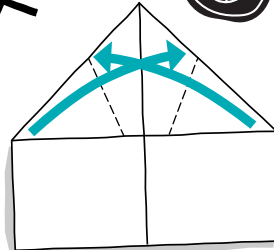
Fold creases then flip

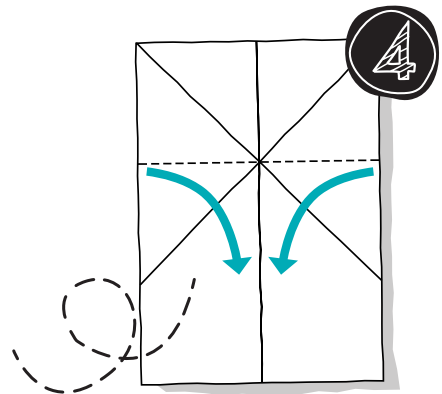
Now put one tab inside the other to form a snug fit that folds down over the other folds



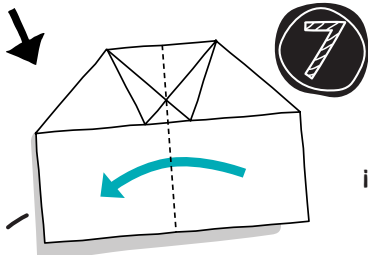

Fold as shown, use markers as a guide



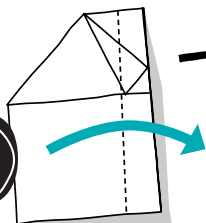
Put your two fingers under the horizontal fold and guide the paper down to meet in the centre as shown. It should collapse into a house shape



Fold back in half

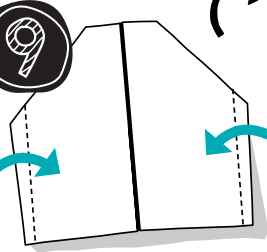

Fold down to form wings

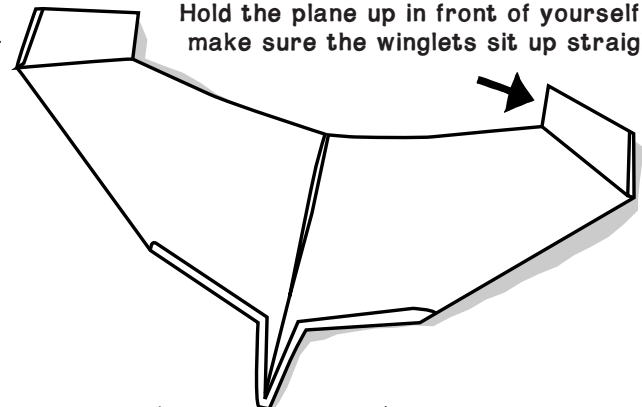
